A Joint Conference on the Pressing Realities of Collective Bargaining
Implementation of the Uniform Fiscal Cycle law

Dear Members and Friends of the University:

The Institute for Governmental Services and the Massachusetts League of Cities and Towns with the support of the Intergovernmental Personnel Act have organized a state-wide invitational conference on selected topics of urgent concern to every invitee. During the balance of the present fiscal year, municipal officials throughout the Commonwealth will be seeking solutions to the problems on the conference agenda enclosed herewith; your active participation would be of great value.

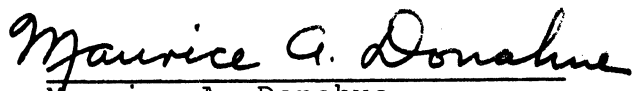
It is anticipated that the conference will involve 100 to 150 selected municipal officials and experts in the respective fields under discussion. The objective will be to identify and recommend action guidelines on the collective bargaining process in the public sector and implementation of the Uniform Fiscal Cycle Act (Massachusetts Statute, 1969, Chapter 849 as amended by 1971, Chapter 766). In accomplishing this goal, the conference will enable local officials to handle the aforementioned problems in a more effective manner, working profitably together with the sponsoring agencies on future problems of mutual concern.

For the edification of "discussion panelists," working papers have been prepared by those experts making formal presentations. At the conference, the role of these experts will be to summarize their positions within thirty to forty-five minutes. Each conference panelist will be asked to react to these presentations and express their own views.

You will find enclosed a copy of the conference agenda and a "buffet" card which must be returned no later than July 10, 1972 since we must provide the University with exact figures at least 48 hours in advance of this function, which is scheduled to take place July 12 at the Campus Center on the Amherst campus.
