To the Honorable, the City Council:

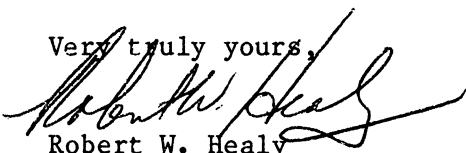
Attached are two orders. First requesting the appropriation of a grant fund for \$2,780.00 from the Department of Education, Bureau of Adult Education to the Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$2,380.00) and Travel & Training Account (\$400.00) to provide additional funds for basic language skills, English as a second language programs and adult secondary education services to Cambridge residents.

The second order is requesting the transfer of \$787.00 in the Grant Fund from Salaries and Wages Account to Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. This transfer is necessary in order to allocate funds in the proper statutory accounts in light of final revisions in the grant award.

The Learning Center appropriated \$89,975.00 of this grant in August and this appropriation of \$2,780.00 brings the total grant award to \$92,755.00.
