WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Temple Street  
should be widened, and

feet in width between

Main and Austin Streets  
included between the red lines as shown on a plan drawn by J. G. Chase,  
City Engineer, dated Feby 7, 1872

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that \_\_\_\_\_ damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, and

for removal of fences, as follows, viz:  
To Chas K. Kirby for 856.6 sq. ft. land @ 1.75 = 1499.05  
Removing 100 ft. fence @ .20 20.00 1519.05  
Wm W. Wellington 384.4 sq. ft. land @ .90 345.96  
Removing 49 ft. fence @ .15 7.35 353.31  
Wm M. Gray 360.6 sq. ft. land @ .90 324.54  
Removing 49 ft. fence @ .15 7.35 331.89  
Chas H. Allen 662.8 sq. ft. land @ 1.00 662.80  
Removing 100 ft. fence @ .25 25.00 687.80  
Total \$ 2892.05

Ordered, That 60 days be allowed to the persons whose land is taken for said widening, for the removal of fences standing on the land so taken as aforesaid.
