ORDERED: That, at the next regularly scheduled Council Session, the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report the status for planned implementation of my Council Orders of 3/18/91 and 6/3/91 (both adopted by the Council) which call for placing stanchions/barrels in the middle of crosswalks at dangerous intersections in the City where no traffic signal is present, with signage attached indicating it is State law that pedestrians have the right of way and that motorists must yield to the exercise of that right.
