- WHEREAS: Lynne was one of the Founders of the Cambridge Professional School Network which is a partnership between the education departments of Cambridge College, Wheelock College, Lesley College and the Cambridge Public School; and
- WHEREAS: Lynne's passing will leave a void in the lives of all her surviving family, her husband Phillip Hyde; her son Benjamin Sussman-Hyde; her father Leonard Sussman; her stepfather Charles Buchholtz; her brothers David and Mark Sussman and Chip Buchholtz; and

Lynne Sussman, at 52, Cambridge College prof

Lynne Sussman of Cambridge, a professor at Cambridge College and a lecturer at the Harvard Graduate School of Education, died Tuesday at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center after a long battle with breast cancer. She was 52.

A graduate of the High School of Music and Arts, Grinnell College and Bank Street College in New York, Mrs. Sussman earned a doctorate in education from Harvard University in 1985. Her first job was at Worcester State College.

Mrs. Sussman was a founding member of the Cambridge Professional School Network, a partnership between the education departments of Cambridge College, Wheelock College,

Lesley College and the Cambridge public schools. She served as co-chairwoman of the Cambridgeport Public School Council, where her son, Benjamin, is a student.

Mrs. Sussman is survived by her husband, Phillip Hyde; a son, Benjamin Sussman-Hyde of Cambridge; her father, Leonard Sussman of New York; her stepfather, Charles Buchholtz of Rutherford, N.J.; and three brothers, David and Mark Sussman, both of New York, and Chip Buchholtz of Philadelphia.

A memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. on Nov. 14 at Cambridge College.
