

There was a landing known as "Berry's Landing" and a way leading to it.

One half of this landing was set off to Waz
laton, Nov. 19, 1870 - Town Records, Vol. A.

Prof. James Hayward's Plan of 1837 - shows
that this way was closed up except about
300 feet at the Western end.

Lucius R. Pajo, in his History of Cam-
bridge, speaks of this way as "long since dis-
continued".

April 24, and May 8, 1847, the City Council
ordered a Botting Place to be established at
"Berry's Landing" - City Records, Vol. III, Pages 320-27.

I find no sale of this land, or record -
just before the incorporation of the City in 1846,
a Committee was appointed to take action in
