February 11, 1990 – Engine Company 9

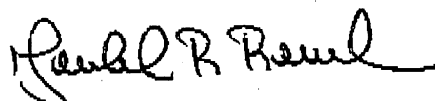
February 11, 1996 – Engine Company 6
