In Board of Aldermen, June 7, 1882

Ordered,

That the Standing Committee on Roads and Bridge, be and hereby is authorized and directed to cause brick sidewalks to be laid as follows:

1. On Brighton street, opposite nos. 19, 21, 23, 25 & 27.
2. On North Avenue opposite no. 137, the same to extend on Mt. Vernon street to the carriage-way of said estate.

Also, Curb stones to be laid on Allston street on southwesterly side, from Pearl street to Southern line of E. W. Henderson, in front of his estate.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the proper appropriation, and estates benefitted to be assessed in accordance with Chapter 191 of the acts of 1862.
