Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Eastern Massachusetts Regional Planning Project has culminated in the "Recommended Highway and Transit Plan" report which was presented February 20, 1969 at our Department Headquarters. Copies of the report have been mailed to those communities not represented at the presentation.

Because of the local contact established through the Transportation Coordinating Committees we believe results of the study generally reflect local desires. Certainly it may not do this to the extent wanted but in the future by working together, we can more adequately blend transportation needs and desires.

At the February 20th presentation we promised to discuss the report with smaller groups of study area communities as soon as possible. This letter is an invitation to such an informal meeting.

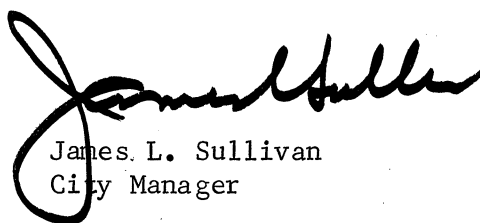
