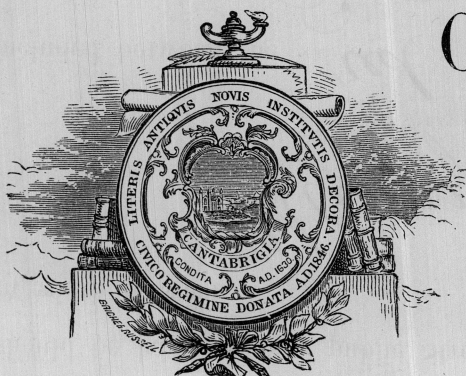




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

dated Sept. 1873.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *No* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
