WHEREAS: The Visiting Nurse Association of Cambridge has been serving the Cambridge community since 1904 by providing home health care to all clients regardless of race, religion, or ability to pay; and

WHEREAS: In addition to skilled nursing rehabilitation therapy, social work, and home health aide services, the Visiting Nurse Association now includes high tech home care, AIDS home care treatment, and specialized maternal and child care; and

WHEREAS: The VNA services are needed more than ever as the City's population ages and desires more home care services, and, as health insurers look for ways to control costs, maintain quality through home health care; and

WHEREAS: The Visiting Nurse Association makes a most valuable contribution to improving the quality of health care for residents of the City of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: In 1990 alone, the staff of 75 was able to provide over 50,000 visits to Cambridge residents; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council proclaims February 17-23, 1991 as Visiting Nurse Association Week; further be it

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Visiting Nurse Association.
