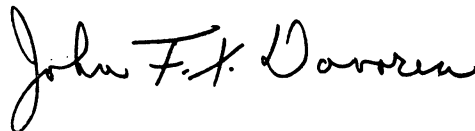

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

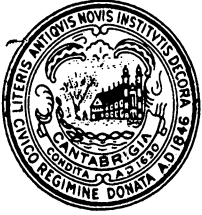
To act as a Missionary of the Mother Church for the propagation and administration of the religious faith, doctrines and practice known as "Scientology", and to act as a mission for the Mother Church in the religious worship, of that faith.

In furtherance of such objects and purpose, the Society and corporation shall regulate and conduct religious services for its congregations, and engage in other activities of a religious and educational nature for the local propagation of the Faith. The purpose of such activities shall be to foster and enhance the spiritual welfare of its followers, and to espouse such evidences of the Supreme Being and Human Spirit as may be knowable to Man and by their use and dissemination to bring a greater tranquility, order, and survival to Man in the external world. Ministers of the Church of Scientology shall have the authority to solemnize marriages and funerals.

In pursuance of its objective, THE CHURCH OF SCIENTOLOGY OF CAMBRIDGE, INC., shall propagate and disseminate The Church Creed as set forth within the by-laws pertaining thereto.

In further pursuance of and not in limitation of the general powers conferred or permitted by law, and to promote the objectives and principles herein set forth, it is provided that this corporation shall also have the following powers:

1. To do all such acts as are necessary or convenient to obtain the objects and purposes herein set forth, to the same extent and as fully as any natural person could or might do and as are not forbidden by law or by this certificate of incorporation or by the by-laws of the corporation.
2. To charter, establish, assist, and conduct its Mission and congregation, and religious school, educational and guidance center.
3. To teach and train personnel; and to sell and distribute books, pictures, pamphlets, documents, tracts, and periodicals, in furtherance of its by-laws, and the Creed and Faith described therein.
4. To engage in social welfare work and charitable undertakings; to accept fees, offerings, and donations for the furtherance of its religious, educational and missionary objectives and work, and generally thereby to minister to the spiritual and interrelated needs of the community.
5. To take, receive, hold, alter, improve and convey real estate and personal property necessary for the purposes of the corporation, and other real and personal property or assets, the income from which shall be applied to the purposes of the corporation, in accordance with law; and to lease, mortgage, execute deeds of trust on, or sell or convey property of the corporation. This corporation has no capital stock.
6. To issue bonds, notes, debentures, and other evidence of indebtedness, and to secure the same by mortgage, deed of trust, or otherwise; to borrow or loan money; to contract and to sue, and, in general, to do all those acts or things necessary to transact the business of the corporation in conformity with its objectives and with the provisions of law applicable to such corporations or societies.
