current wording – “The applicant must also include signed abutter’s forms of those abutters in front, side, rear, and across the street from the property which the curb cut will be made. ...”

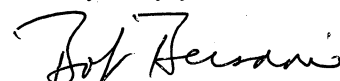
changed wording – “The applicant must also include signed forms from abutters on the sides and rear of the property and from all property owners located across the street(s) from the property.”

Application form(1st page, 2nd para.)

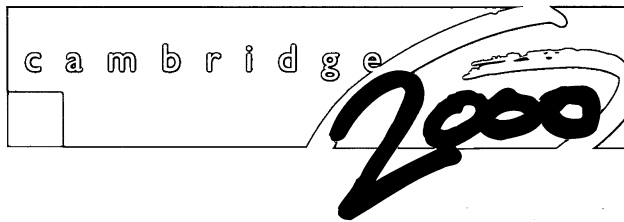
Current wording - “... You must also include a signed abutter sheet for each of your abutters: back yard, one on either side and the abutter directly across the street.”
