WHEREAS: President Ford served on an aircraft carrier in the Navy during World War II; and

WHEREAS: President Ford was elected to the United States House in 1948 as a Republican which represented a district that included his hometown of Grand Rapids, Michigan, and served 25 years in Congress, working his way up to minority leader in 1965; and

WHEREAS: In October of 1973 Gerald Ford replaced Spiro Agnew as Vice President of the United States and became later became the 38th President of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS: President Ford's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife Betty; his children Michael, Jack, Steven and Susan; his grandchildren; his great grandchildren; and his many friends and colleagues; now therefore be it
