The following information has been requested by City Clerk Paul Healy relative to our request for a \$1,200.00 transfer to our G-17 Account, dated December 1, 1972.

This amount of money will be used for the replacement of supplies of tear gas, etc. used in training and at disturbances. Also, for the replacement of uniforms worn out or torn by our Tactical Force. Protective grills were installed on two police vehicles.

In the 1972 budget we requested the amount of \$9,946.00 and we were allowed only \$2,500.00 for the year.
