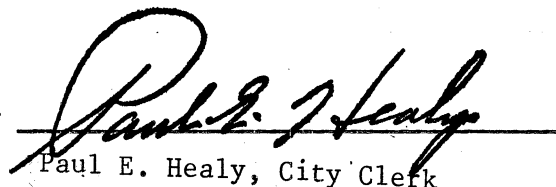

- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Antonio de Jesus Cardozo, Esquire, a long time Portuguese-American civic leader; and
- WHEREAS: Tony was born in the Cape Verde Islands and raised in Portugal until the age of seventeen, when he immigrated to America to work as a cowboy on his uncle's California ranch and having done that, he later came East, where he attended high school and continued on to earn his law degree at Suffolk Law School, working nights in order to support himself and when the Fletcher School at Tufts University opened in 1933, he was one of the first to enroll and become one of the first twenty-one students to graduate; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout his adult life he has been deeply involved in the practice of law, specializing in laws involving foreign countries and handling legal work for various consulates in the area, while also being extremely active in the Portuguese-American community in Cambridge, serving as clerk, attorney and director for more than forty years at the Cambridge Portuguese Credit Union, among other organizations; and
- WHEREAS: In recognition of his many achievements throughout the years with the Portuguese-American community, Tony was awarded the Medal of the Fifth Century of Prince Henry the Navigator in 1965 and in 1972 received the Commandador de Ordem de Benemerencia from the President of the Republic of Portugal; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Virginia Cardozo and the entire Cardozo family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
