WHEREAS: Ensign Hill has served on board USS HORNE, a San Diego based guided missile cruiser, since May, 1990, and was deployed in early December as part of the Middle East Force; and

WHEREAS: In a citation signed by Rear Admiral Raynor Taylor, Ensign Hill is cited for "consistently performed demanding duties in an exemplary and highly professional manner...Ensign Hill's exceptional professional ability, initiative and dedication to duty reflected great credit upon himself, his command and the United States Naval Service."; and

WHEREAS: Ensign Hill continues the family tradition of a dedicated Naval Service to the United States following in the footsteps of his three uncles Bernard, John and Leonard Hill who served during World War II and the Korean Conflict; now therefore be it

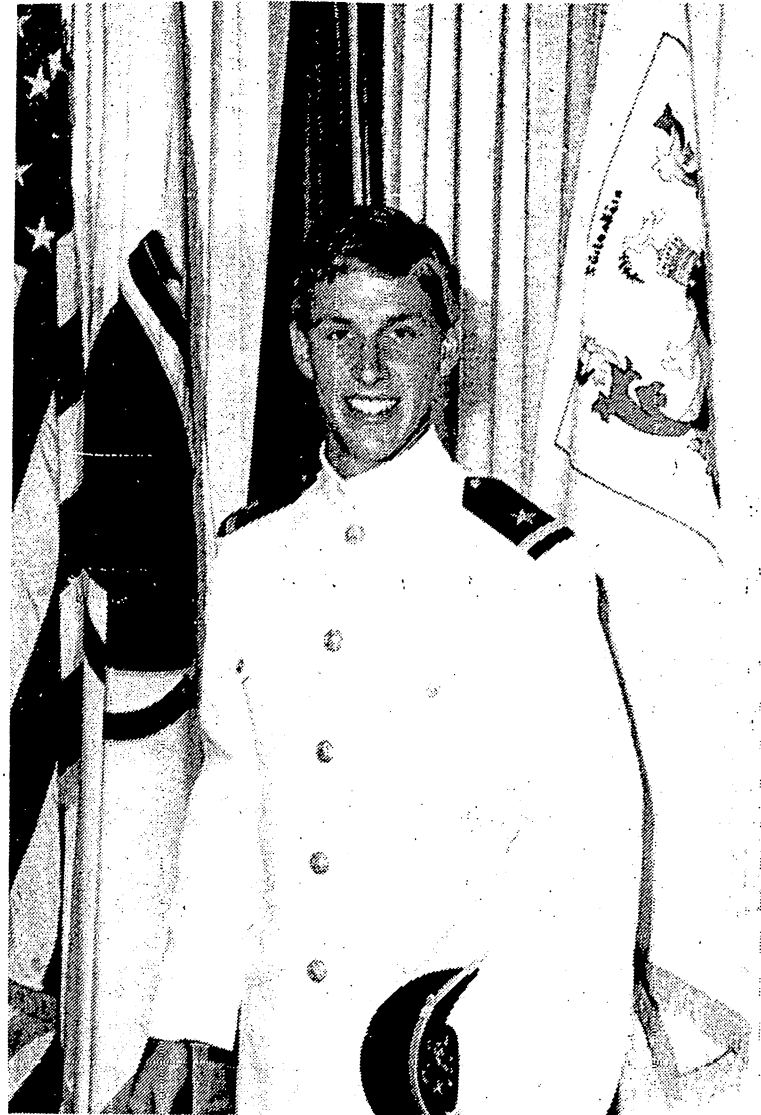
Hill awarded Navy medal

Lieutenant (junior grade) Lawrence D. Hill Jr. of Stoneham was awarded the Navy Achievement Medal at an awards ceremony held at Naval Station, San Diego, California on November 15. The medal was presented for "professional achievement while serving from January 24 to April 17, 1991 as Main Engines Officer in USS HORNE (CG 30) while deployed to the Middle East Force in support of Operation Desert Storm."

Hill has served on board USS HORNE, a San Diego based guided missile cruiser, since May, 1990, and was deployed in early December as part of the Middle East Force. While on station in the northern Arabian Gulf during Operation Desert Storm, USS HORNE provided anti-aircraft support for allied forces, and directed naval air strikes against Iraqi surface units. Additionally, on the morning of February 18, 1991, USS HORNE was operating 10 miles northwest of USS TRIPOLI and seven miles northeast of USS PRINCETON when those vessels were struck by enemy mines. USS HORNE re-

mained in place during the attack, and provided anti-air protection while the damaged vessels were towed from the area. USS HORNE was awarded the Southwest Asia Service Medal and Navy Unit Commendation for its Gulf War operations against Iraqi armed forces.

According to the citation signed by Rear Admiral Raynor Taylor, "Ensign Hill consistently performed; demanding duties in an exemplary and highly professional manner. Demonstrating professional knowledge and initiative, he instituted a comprehensive upgrade program for all main machinery equipment, resulting in flawless operation of HORNE's main engines throughout the deployment. Assigned as Repair Five Locker Officer, he rapidly mastered advanced damage control while simultaneously training all locker personnel to meet any potential threats and leading his team to consistently superior scores in watertight integrity and fire party performance during shipboard drills.



His diligent efforts and resourcefulness inspired all who observed him and contributed significantly to the accomplishment of HORNE's and Middle East Force's mission. Ensign Hill's exceptional professional

ability, initiative and dedication to duty reflected great credit upon himself, his command, and the United States Naval Service."

Hill is a 1984 graduate of Stoneham High School.
