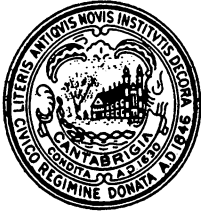
This is in response to your letter of May 22, 1975, requesting us to review and to report on City Council order of May 12, 1975, seeking to reduce the size of the lot of land located at the corner of Cambridge Street and Webster Avenue in order to widen that intersection and thereby to improve traffic conditions.

There have been several discussions on this matter with the Department of Traffic and Parking, and the Authority's engineering consultants, together with Department of Traffic and Parking staff, have prepared preliminary sketches of the proposed redesign of the intersection. This redesign has been made a part of the project improvement schedule for that location, and will be placed in final design and construction at the time adjacent parcels are redeveloped, provided that Federal and/or local funds are available for such purposes.

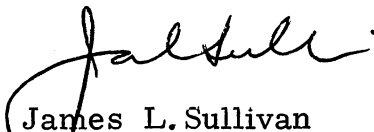
