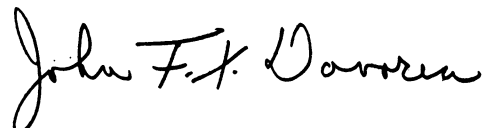

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

Health Club

The general purpose and plan of operation shall be to own, purchase, lease, in whole or in part, acquire, operate, use, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of real estate and buildings necessary, expedient or proper to maintain a health club, to promote and encourage all manly sports and physical culture, and to conduct a club for the purpose of providing for the refreshment, entertainment, exercise and social diversion of it's members, which shall include the sale of food and the dispensation of beverages including alcohol.

NOTE: If provisions for which the space provided under Articles 2, 3 and 4 is not sufficient additions should be set out on continuation sheets to be numbered 2A, 2B, etc. Indicate under each Article where the provision is set out. Continuation sheets shall be on 8 1/4" x 11" paper and must have a left-hand margin 1 inch wide for

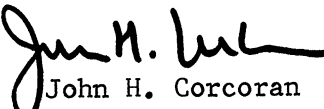
