- WHEREAS: Numerous citizens, including joggers, strollers and mothers with baby carriages take advantage of the path around Fresh Pond; and
- WHEREAS: The access path from Huron Avenue in the vicinity of Park Avenue down to the pond is blocked by a tree that fell during Hurricane "Gloria" back in the Fall; and
- WHEREAS: The muddy conditions in the spring make passage for baby carriages difficult; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager request the Public Works Department to clear the path and look into the possibility of installing hot top on the path to make it more accessible for our citizens.
