ORDERED: That, since such enforcement cannot be continual, the Traffic and Parking Department be requested to review the situation and to recommend options that respond to this danger, including street closings, speed bumps, or other options that can really slow down the automobiles; and further be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the Council.
