SOME ONE WITH ONE.

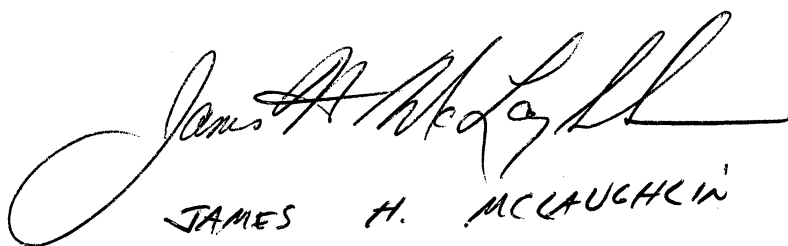
I HAVE TWO REQUESTS.
