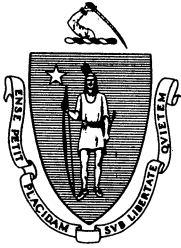

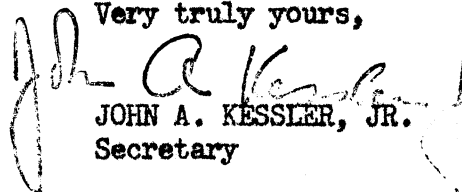

In Metropolitan District Commission
Boston, Mass., January 29, 1976

ORDERED that, on petition of Boston Edison Company, dated November 26, 1975, for locations shown on plans of Boston Edison Company, dated September 6, 1972 and November 29, 1973 (both revised September 8, 1975), and indexed accession numbers 48922-A-X to 48926-A-X revised, for two manholes, two test stations and steel pipes, with the necessary wires, cables and related apparatus therein, in Alewife Brook Parkway, in the City of Cambridge and the Town of Arlington, a distance of approximately 4,965 feet, to be used for the transmission of electricity, said locations being under the care and control of this Commission, and found by order of the Department of Public Utilities to be required by public convenience and necessity, said plans and petition being on file in the office of the Commission, a hearing on said petition having been given by this Commission on Thursday, January 29, 1976, at 10:00 A.M., at the office of the Commission in Boston, of which hearing due notice was given to all persons interested of the time and place by publishing a copy of said petition and the order of notice issued thereon by this Commission in newspapers published in the City of Cambridge and Town of Arlington, being the city and town in which the locations petitioned for would lie, the first publication having been made at least fourteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and it appearing, in the opinion of this Commission, that public convenience and necessity so require, said Boston Edison Company is hereby granted locations for said manholes, test stations and steel pipes, with necessary wires, cables, and related apparatus therein, in said Alewife Brook Parkway, Cambridge and Arlington, to the extent and upon the terms, conditions, and obligations hereinafter specified, the same being such as the public necessity and a due regard for the rights of the Commonwealth require, namely:-

1. The Boston Edison Company shall conform to all provisions of law applicable to the exercise of the rights and performance of the work under this grant and to the rules and regulations of the Metropolitan District Commission.

2. The Boston Edison Company shall do the work of installing said manholes, test stations and steel pipes, with the necessary wires, cables and related apparatus therein, in the locations

hereby granted subject to the approval of the Director of Park Engineering and Chief Engineer - M.D.C., of the Commission, as to time, manner, and locations, and in all other respects.

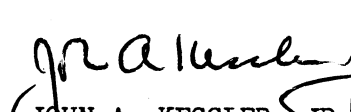
3. The Boston Edison Company shall indemnify and save harmless the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Metropolitan District Commission from any damage it or they may sustain or be required to pay arising out of the exercise by said Company or any of its employees in connection with the work done hereunder.

4. The Boston Edison Company shall protect and maintain all trees, drainage or water pipes, and all appurtenances or structures either above or below the surface of the ground over which these locations lie, and upon completion of the work shall restore the surface of the ground to the condition in which it was at the time of this grant, and in a manner satisfactory to said Director of Park Engineering, and Chief Engineer - M.D.C., of the Commission, and shall maintain the surface of the ground and the location throughout in such condition to the satisfaction of said Director, and Chief Engineer.

5. The Boston Edison Company shall place and maintain proper barriers at all times and from the beginning of twilight through the whole of every night sufficient lights to protect the public from injury or damage during the progress of the work under this grant or during repairs upon said manholes, test stations and steel pipes, wires, cables and related apparatus therein, and work on the locations which may hereafter become necessary.

6. No work shall be done under this grant without first obtaining a permit therefor from said Director of Park Engineering, and subject to conditions imposed by him, and the Chief, Engineer - M.D.C.
