Gentlemen:

By an order of the City Council approved by the Mayor October 19, 1916, the Fresh Pond Realty Co. was assessed the sum of \$106.68 for the construction of a sewer in Larchwood Drive--a sewer constructed under an order approved October 22, 1915--said lot being numbered 15 on Block Plan 250.

It appears, however, that this lot had been conveyed by the Fresh Pond Parkway Realty Co. to Eleanor Tudor in July, 1915. I recommend there fore that the above assessment of \$106.68 be abated from the Fresh Pond Parkway Realty Co. and that the same be re-assessed to Eleanor Tudor.

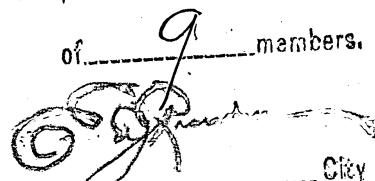
ORDERED:

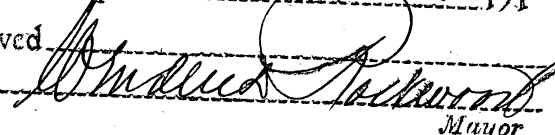
That the assessment levied upon the Fresh Pond Parkway
