That this City Council go on record extending our sincere best wishes to Mrs. Clotilda Casassa on the happy occasion of her 100th birthday, and be it further

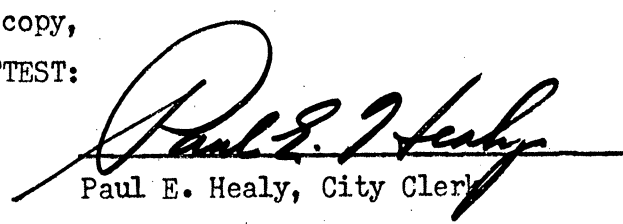
RESOLVED:
