In Board of Aldermen, Oct 13. 1869

Ordered: that the Superintendent of Streets be directed to lay a stone wall ^{on main st} from Ellery to Dana Sts in front of the estates of Mrs. Livermore & of Mess. Cushman, Richardson & Humphrey in accordance with the plan prepared by Ryder & Harris at a cost not to exceed One Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars the expense to be charged to the Appropriation for Incidental Expenses

This order to take effect when the persons named shall have signed an agreement drawn up by the City Solicitor waiving all claim to damages ~~by change of grade~~ & all title to the fences now standing in front of their estates.
