and Seventy Six.

An Ordinance in relation to the Fire Department,

As it ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows,

Art. 1. Each Steamfire-engine Company appointed
by the Mayor and Aldermen shall consist
of twelve men, and each Hook & Ladder
Company shall consist of seventeen men,

Art. 2. Hereafter Steamfire-engine Companies shall
not ballot for Assistant Foremen of their
respective Companies, but the Drivers of
Hose Carriages shall, in addition to their
other duties, perform those ~~those~~ required
by Sect. 11 of Chap. 10 of the Revised Ordinances
without extra compensation therefor,

Art. 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in-
consistent with Sections One and Two of this
Ordinance are hereby repealed.
