COUNCILLOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: Many orders have been through the City Council regarding the signalization of the intersection of Sparks, Brattle and Craigie Street, which continues to be a serious problem; and
- WHEREAS: The Traffic Department is in the process of studying the intersection with the view in mind of making it a fully signalized intersection; and
- WHEREAS: Full signalization might take a long period of time to implement, and daily "near misses" are occurring; and
- WHEREAS: There is a simple solution that could be made to ensure the safety of pedestrians and motor vehicles on a temporary basis until the permanent installation is made; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Traffic Department look into the feasibility of painting white lines on Sparks Street and entering the intersection and installing "left lane for left turn" and "right lane for right turn" signs at the corner and report back to the City Council within two weeks.
