EVENT CELLULAR COMMUNICATIONS/SHARED TECHNOLOGIES, INC.

Event Cellular Communications, Inc. ("ECC") and Shared Technologies, Inc. ("STI") have filed a joint petition requesting approval by the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") for the transfer of the certificate of public convenience and necessity held by ECC to STI, pursuant to 220 C.M.R. 35.08. ECC is authorized to provide cellular radio telephone services in Massachusetts. STI has agreed to purchase all of the stock of ECC and to operate as a wholly-owned subsidiary of STI.

The transferee intends to operate in Massachusetts under ECC's current tariff on file with the Department, M.D.P.U. Tariff No. 1.

The above investigation is officially captioned:

Joint petition of Event Cellular Communications, Inc. and Shared Technologies Inc., pursuant to 220 C.M.R., Section 35.08 for approval to transfer the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Shared Technologies Inc.

The Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing at its hearing room, 1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Wednesday, December 4, 1991 at 10:00 a.m.

The petitioners, Event Cellular Communications and Shared Technologies, Inc. are required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield, the Springfield Union News (Springfield) and the Worcester Telegram (Worcester), to serve a copy hereof on all parties on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication at the time of the hearing.
