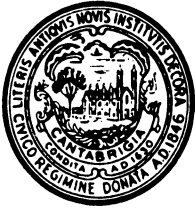
The East Cambridge Parking Garage has the following firms and number of spaces leased according to the Community Development Department.

1. Middlesex County Commissioners	50 spaces
2. Bulfinch Square Associates	90 spaces
3. One Canal Park	100 spaces
4. Edgewater Place	30 spaces
5. Ten Canal Park	75 spaces
6. Davenport Bldg.	250 spaces
Total spaces committed 595 spaces	

This total of 595 spaces are the maximum committed under the Community Development UDAG Program and at the present time they are using 350 spaces and as their development progresses they will add 245 more spaces.

As for the attorney's hired relative to the garage, I believe the Community Development Office can supply you with any names as they were the agency responsible for the construction and negotiations for parking in this facility.

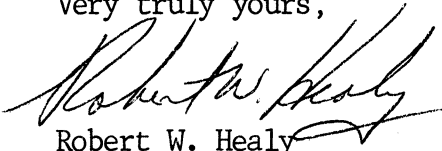
