An Ordinance in amendment of an Ordinance
in relation to the City Messenger.

Be it ordained, by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge, as follows:

Chapter 16 of the Revised Ordinances is hereby
amended by adding a section as follows, to wit:
"Section 3. The City Messenger shall, acting
under the direction of the Committee on Stationery
and Printing, purchase all supplies of stationery
required for the use of the City Council and de-
partments acting thereunder. He shall keep a
detailed account of all such purchases, and
deliveries from the same, and shall furnish
each department only upon a requisition,
signed by the head of such department,
and take a receipt therefor.

He shall report to the City Council annually,
or oftener if called for, giving a detailed state-
ment of purchases, deliveries and stock on
hand.
