In the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty six

An Ordinance
Establishing the salaries of the Mayor and City Clerk, and for other purposes

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Section One—From and after the first Monday in January, 1867, the Mayor of the City shall receive an annual salary of Twenty five hundred dollars; and the City Clerk an annual salary of two thousand dollars, exclusive of fees established by law; which salaries shall be paid in equal quarterly payments, and shall be in full for all services rendered by said officers, in their official capacity

Section Two. From and after the first Monday in January, 1867, there shall be allowed and paid to the City Clerk, the sum of one thousand dollars, per annum, in equal quarterly payments; the same to be expended by him for clerical assistance in his office

Section Three. All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this are hereby repealed
