

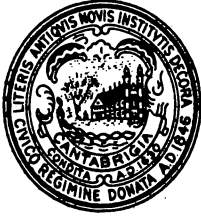



To the Honorable, the City Council,

Enclosed for your approval is an appropriation order to partially cover the salary costs of the most recent Police contract.
