COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

WHEREAS: The General Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts finds that presently, Massachusetts has the highest unemployment rate of any state in the continental United States; and

WHEREAS: The youth (under age 25) are the hardest hit particularly Black and other minority youth;

RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council endorses H.R. 3258 the purpose of which Act is to require that the state of Massachusetts commit itself to full employment for youth by providing 90,000 jobs within the next year insuring that no person in Massachusetts shall on the grounds of sex, age, race, color, religion, political belief, or national origin be excluded from participation in this program.
