IN CITY COUNCIL

May 12, 1980

- WHEREAS: Harry J. White, a former employee of the Cambridge City Hospital and the Department of Public Welfare of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the City of Cambridge on August 15, 1931 and was pensioned on April 30, 1963 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 58 of the General Laws and died on January 13, 1973, having served not less than thirty-one years; and
- WHEREAS: At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Adelaide White, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Harry J. White, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Adelaide White, widow of Harry J. White, of \$3,000 per year as long as she does not marry.



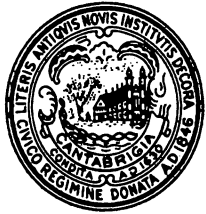


