The League of Women Voters of Cambridge objects to the City Council rejection of the September 9, 1985 motion to put the Chapter 25, Human Rights amendment question on the ballot for the November 5, 1985 city election.

In so doing we are addressing the process, not the referendum issue itself.

The refusal of the City Council to put the question on the ballot appears to be a violation of section 39 of the City Charter of Cambridge. Said section concerning the right of citizens' initiative petition in local legislation.

Therefore, the League of Women Voters of Cambridge urges the City Council to vote to place the Chapter 25, Human Rights amendment question on the ballot for the November 5, 1985 city election.
