IN CITY COUNCIL

June 2, 1975

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Victor - Bell Development of 929 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge to obstruct the sidewalk at the premises numbered 890-892 Massachusetts Avenue for a period of five months commencing June 16, 1975 during the construction of a new office building.

Said permit to be granted subject to the following conditions:-

1. A barricade constructed of plywood, posts and a roof of sturdy wooden construction for the protection of pedestrians who use this area during the period of construction to be erected in the public way suitably lighted as to prevent any injury to vehicles and pedestrians using this street.
2. Said obstruction to occupy the entire sidewalk and said barricade to occupy a distance of fifty feet of the public way from the curb line in such a manner to provide for the safe passage of vehicles in the two-way traffic system that currently exists on said street.
3. The contractor to restore existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
4. That no existing travel lanes shall be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
5. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street construction permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge.
6. That the conditions having specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge who may as he deems necessary require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.
7. The contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricade during the period of construction.
