- WHEREAS: The members of this Council grieved deeply upon hearing of the sudden and tragic death of Nialini Lee; and
- WHEREAS: Nialini was a member of the Lee family whose members have lived in Cambridge since prior to the Civil War. She was the great granddaughter of Herbert Lee, Sr. of Hingham Street. Her grandparents, the late Willis Lee and his surviving widow, Virginia Lee Williams, were Cambridge citizens. Her mother, Lurena was a resident of Cambridge, and Nialini attended the Cambridge Montessori School; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record as extending sympathy to Nialini's mother, Lurena, and to all the members of the Lee family; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Acting City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution to Nialini's grandmother, Mrs. Virginia Lee Williams, 65 Morton Village Drive, Mattapan, Massachusetts.
