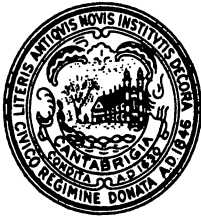
It is the plan of the Traffic Department to have all the old church signs in the City replaced by the end of the year.


