In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-one.

An Ordinance  
in relation to the care of School Houses.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:-

Sec. 1. The third section of the Ordinance in relation to Schools, page 150 of the Ordinances of 1857, is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. The Mayor and Aldermen shall employ suitable persons to keep the Schoolhouses of the City clean and in good order, and properly warmed and ventilated; and <sup>the persons so employed</sup> shall also render such assistance to the Committee as that Committee may, from time to time, require.
