COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

- ORDERED: That this City Council go on record requesting the City Manager to direct the City Solicitor to enjoin the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Department of Corrections from utilizing and occupying the proposed jail facility in the East Cambridge Court House, which occupancy would be in violation of the Building Code of the Commonwealth and would constitute a fire trap for anyone incarcerated in this building; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Chief of the Fire Department, the Superintendent of Buildings of the City of Cambridge and any other official concerned to refrain from issuing any permits to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for the occupancy of said building in view of the fact that there is no adequate sprinkler system installed for the protection and safety of all persons who would use this facility; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Solicitor be and hereby is requested to do everything in his power to legally enforce the intent of of this order and prevent the use of the court house building as a Department of Corrections Facility.
