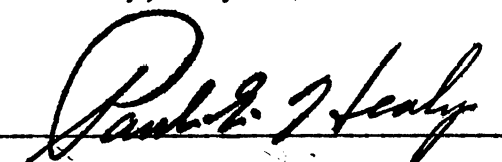

- WHEREAS: Wilfred, a Cambridge native, joined the Fire Department on June 16, 1957, having been on the "Reserve List" since 1953 and was assigned to Ladder Company #1, remaining at that assignment until November 24, 1964 at which time he was assigned to Ladder Company #4; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Bennett transferred back to Ladder Company #1 on March 17, 1968 and remained in that assignment until October 29, 1972, at which time he was transferred to Engine Company #9, the assignment from which he will soon retire; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Bennett, a World War II veteran and dedicated public employee will be missed by his many friends and associates; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and best wishes to Firefighter Wilfred A. Bennett for his dedication to duty during his many years of service and to further wish him every good wish for good health and happiness in the years ahead; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to him on behalf of the entire City Council.
