That the Order adopted by this Board directing Benjamin Welch to remove certain obstructions on Hampshire Street, before the first day of June next, be further modified, so as to allow him until the first day of June 1855 for the removal of the Piazza of his house west of Norfolk Street, but that he be required to remove the bank in front of said house and the front steps of the same, so that they shall not project beyond the line of said Piazza, before the first day of June now next ensuing.
