I was unaware of the May 15, 1995 outcome until I received a flyer on my car. On May 16 I called and spoke to you about the outcome of the councillor's meeting. I felt that my concerns were answered by you. But I also contacted the Cambridge Development Department and spoke to Roger Boothe. At that time I asked to be notified of all upcoming meeting regarding the Quincy Sq. development. I asked to be put on ALL the mailing lists that pertained to the Quincy Sq. Development.
