To the Honorable, the Board of Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge

The undersigned respectfully pray

That a brick sidewalk may be constructed upon the Westerly side of Lowell Street in said City, from the Southerly line of Brattle Street to the Northerly line of the land of Helen P. Ellis; and that edgestones may be set upon said side of said street, between said bounds, where the same do not already exist: the distance between said two points being $439 \frac{28}{100}$ feet; for 145 feet of which edgestones have already been set, so that the total length of edgestones will be $294 \frac{28}{100}$ feet, and of brick sidewalk $439 \frac{28}{100}$ feet.
