IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-

AN ACT

RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS IN THE
CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter eighty-three of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and nineteen as amended by Chapter ninety-five of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two is hereby further amended as follows, by striking out the first paragraph of Section 1 of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Section 1. There is hereby established in the City of Cambridge a board of license commissioners consisting of three persons, who shall be appointed by the City Manager for a term of three years subject to the provisions of the city charter.

SECTION 2. Said chapter ninety-five of the Special Acts of nineteen hundred and twenty-two is hereby further amended by adding the following: "Section 2. The chiefs of the police and fire departments, and the building commissioner of the city shall make such investigative reports as are requested by the board of license commissioners concerning any license, licensee or applicant for such license under the powers of said board.

SECTION 3. The members initially appointed under this act shall be as follows: the first member shall be for a term of one year; the second for two years and the third for three years. All succeeding terms shall be for three years.
