The War Department has under consideration the application of the City of Boston, by its Commissioner of Public Works, for a permit to dump snow and ice into tidewaters of Boston Harbor during the winter of 1946-47, from the following locations:

Warren Bridge, Charlestown;
Charlestown Bridge;
Dorchester Avenue, from Congress St. to Dorchester Ave. Bridge;
Public Works Dept. Wharf, 636 Albany St.;
Long Wharf and T Wharf, Atlantic Ave;
Atlantic Ave., at various points between Rowes Wharf and Eastern Ave., from scuppers in sidewalk;
Sleeper St. at Northern Ave., on South Boston side of Fort Point Channel;
Leverett St., at Viaduct (Lomasney Park);
Mystic River from Charlestown playground;
Chelsea Creek, from Condor St., between Putnam and Glendon Sts., East Boston;
Dover Street Bridge;
Northern Ave., South Boston, between Pier No. 2 and Pier No. 4 of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Co.;
Battery Street, City proper, at former location of North Ferry;
In Charles River, from 6 openings in sidewalk on upstream side of Harvard Bridge.

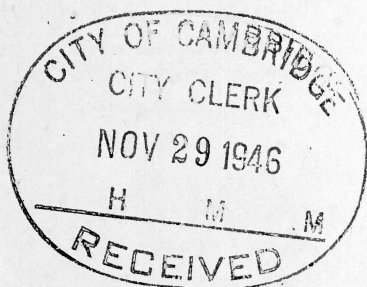

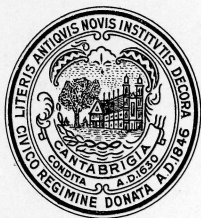
