That the Committee on Ordinances be instructed to consider the expediency of providing by Ordinance, that the City-Treasurer ~~sh~~ be required to take individual receipts from employees of the City, as now required by Order adopted in March 1875; And that Committee be required to advertise for proposals for furnishing materials and supplies required in their several departments, whenever the cost of same shall exceed the sum of \$500, - as now required by Order adopted in June, 1875.
