We have reviewed the proposal from Crystal Transport, Inc. to operate a bus shuttle between MIT and Wellesley to accommodate students in an MIT-Wellesley College exchange program.

We cannot recommend approval of the bus route which was originally requested as it went through Harvard Square.

We do recommend approval be granted for Crystal Transport, Inc. to operate a shuttle bus service on the following public ways in the City of Cambridge.

- River Street from Memorial Drive to Massachusetts Avenue
- Massachusetts Avenue between River Street and Vassar Street
- Vassar Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Main Street
- Main Street between Vassar Street and Ames Street
- Ames Street between Main Street and Memorial Drive
- Wadsworth Street from Memorial Drive to Amherst Street
- Amherst Street from Wadsworth Street to Ames Street
- Sidney Street from Massachusetts Avenue to Green Street

Subject Petition of Camper Tours, Inc.

I have reviewed the proposal of Camper Tours, Inc. for a license to operate motor vehicles, for the carriage of passengers for hire over certain specified public ways in the City of Cambridge. The City Council had a meeting concerning the number of public carriers now operating on our streets and the results were that there are now too many of these buses operating in the City and that some way must be found to cut down the total number.

It is my opinion that with the extension of the Red Line to Alewife, we should encourage the use of this service. One of the reasons it was extended was to remove vehicles and buses from our public ways, to allow more buses into the City would be contrary to our desires.

It is also my opinion that there is now adequate public transportation from Boston to Cambridge and also from the south shore. Although they only propose two trips per day, added to all the others, we are increasing the problem of congestion. There would also be a problem of layovers as Cambridge would be the terminus of this service. Therefore they would require a location to layover in order to meet their schedule.

The Committee was in receipt of a communication from Traffic and Parking Director, George Teso, outlining his concern that too many such services generate excess traffic in the community, particularly with the recent opening of the Alewife and the Red Line extension.

Attorney Keohane stated that his client provides a service of transporting people from suburban mobil and camper homes in an effort to reduce the number of cars coming into the city.

Mayor Russell questioned if anyone was in opposition to the petition. Mr. Arthur Santoro, Campus Taxi Cab stated he thought there were already too many buses and vans traveling thorough the city. He further stated that these vans are making stops at the hotels and thereby potentially can take business from the taxi industry.

Mr. Johnson stated that they had not yet requested approval from the Department of Public Utilities but have been given a license from Foxborough, Bellingham and Wrentham.

Councillor Walter Sullivan moved that the petition as amended be referred without recommendation to the full City Council.

The hearing was adjourned at 4:42 PM.

The The Committee on Transportation conducted a public hearing on Thursday, April 11, 1985 beginning at 4:00 PM in the City Council Chamber, City Hall. The purpose of the hearing was to review and consider the following petitions:

1. Crystal Transport, Inc. for the carriage of passengers, pursuant to C. 159A MGLA between Wellesley College and M.I.T.
2. Camper Tours Inc., for the carriage of passengers for hire pursuant to C. 159 A MGLA over certain public ways of Cambridge.

Councillor Walter Sullivan, presided in the absence of the Chairman, Councillor Daniel J. Clinton and stated that the Chairman was unable to attend the hearing due to a death in the family.

At this time Attorney Arthur M. White representing Crystal Transport Inc. and John McConnon, the General Manager of Crystal appeared before the committee and outlined their proposal (copy attached). Attorney White stated that his client has already received a temporary license to operate for the Department of Public Utilities as well as licenses from the towns through which they travel in order to get to Cambridge. He further stated that the buses used in this effort are 1984 transport/air conditioned vans and the drivers are licensed professionals versus students. He further stated that they would only be transporting students and faculty from Wellesley College to Cambridge with return trips.

Councillor Walter Sullivan questioned if there was anyone in opposition to the petition. At this time Mr. Arthur Santoro, owner and operator of the Campus Taxi Cab stated he believed Wellesley already had a bus route coming into Cambridge and there was not a need to have another. He stated he was opposed.

Mayor Leonard Russell responded by stating it is out of the jurisdiction of the city to attempt to suggest to another community how to operate their commuter service.

Councillor Walter Sullivan (Mayor Russell is now in Chair) moved that the petition be reported favorably to the full City Council. The motion carried.

At this time the Committee heard from Attorney Howard Keohane representing Camper Tours Inc. along with Arthur Johnson, President, who outlined their proposal (copy attached). Attorney Keohane stated that only two wheels will be involved in their operation which will originate in Foxborough and Wrentham. He further stated that in addition to the original petition submitted in February, they had also submitted an amendment in March requesting the use of two additional streets, namely Craigie Street between Concord Avenue and Brattle Street and Brattle Street between Mason Street and Craigie Street.
