ORDERED:-

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Superintendent of Streets be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Neapolitan Ice Cream Co. Inc. for the erection of a sign at No. 190 Concord Avenue.

Provided that before erecting the above named sign the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

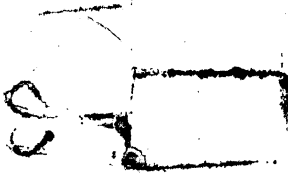
